The present petition is filed for wilful disobedience of the directions of this Court issued on 29.11.2018 in CWP No. 7847 of 2015.

The petitioner filed the writ petition seeking family pension and other benefits accruing to the legal heirs of her late husband. The petition was disposed of directing the respondents to decide the issue regarding release of dues to the legal heirs.

Learned counsel for the respondents has handed over copy of order dated 28.3.2019 to learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is submitted that as per the said order, the petitioner i.e. widow is entitled to gratuity, leave encashment and General Provident Fund and there are certain formalities to be completed for which she has to come

to the office of respondent No. 2 and thereafter the amount would be released. It is further stated that with regard to family pension, there is a dispute as the mother of deceased-Manoj Kumar has moved a complaint that the widow has re-married and she is not entitled to family pension. The matter is being looked into by the respondents and a decision would be taken as expeditiously as possible after verifying the facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner disputes the fact of re-marriage.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

Let the petitioner appear in the office of respondent No. 2 on 17.12.2019 at 12.00 noon. The respondents shall provide the list of formalities to be completed. On doing the needful by the petitioner, the amount be released to her within four weeks thereafter. With regard to the issue of family pension, the respondents shall take the decision within twelve weeks. The petitioner as well as mother of deceased-Manoj Kumar be given an opportunity to put forth their claims.
