The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 249 dated 12.06.2019, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Section 63 of the Copyright Act, 1963, besides, Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the recovery of liquor was effected from the rented premises of the petitioner on 12.06.2019. He also contends that a reception for the marriage of the petitioner was slated on 12.06.2019. He has also referred to the copy of the invitation card at Annexure P2. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 06.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but documents have to be recovered from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier appeared before the Investigating Officer on 03 occasions and handed over all the documents.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 06.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
