In the present writ petition, the grievance which has been raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners have not been paid the revised DCRG/Leave encashment in view of fixation of the pay retrospectively w.e.f. 25.07.2013. When the case came up for hearing on 02.11.2018, none appeared on behalf of the petitioners and the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel representing the respondents-State, on instructions from Mr. Chander Mohan, Senior Assistant, contended that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the entire payment, as claimed in the writ petition, has been made.

Since, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 10.12.2018.”

Today again, there is no representation on behalf of the

petitioners.

Keeping in view the fact that there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners and as per statement made on behalf of the respondents, all the benefits for which the petitioners were entitled for have already been made, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition.

However, in case the petitioners feel that they are entitled for any other benefits or the benefits have not been released to them in entirety, the petitioners will be at liberty to file a representation with the respondents to claim the same within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Counsel for the respondents undertakes that if any representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will be decided expeditiously within a period of three months from the date of filing of such representation.
