The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 844 dated 23.11.2018 registered under Sections 302 and 201 of IPC, 1860 and read with Section 34 of IPC, at Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is wife of deceased-Charanjit and Charanjit was cremated on 16.11.2018 in the presence of complainant-Om Parkash, who is father of the deceased. Now, Om Parkash has stepped into the witness box and stated that before cremation, he had seen injuries on the body of his son deceased-Charanjit.

On the instructions from SI Satbir Singh, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that till now out of 27 witnesses, only

9 witnesses have been examined.

Learned counsel for the complainant has stated that the minor children Sneha and Vishal have also stepped into the witness box and have specifically stated in respect of the role of the petitioner.

Without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
