On 21.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.78 dated 22.07.2019 registered under Section 381 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the Court of Sessions has allowed the application for pre-arrest bail to Amandeep Singh @ Amandeep Kumar, the Accessory Manager whereas prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner has been denied on the ground that he is not the Accessory Manager which is factually incorrect as the petitioner was working as accessory fitter.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. S.P.S. Tinna, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A

copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 03.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mewa Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

Hence, order dated 21.08.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
