Reply dated 23.10.2019 by way of affidavit of Sh. Hussan Lal, IAS, Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of PWD (B&R), Punjab filed in Court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Sh. Birbal, Superintendent states that case of the petitioner has been considered and it has been decided to release within three weeks from today the amount of Group Insurance Scheme as well as interest on delayed payment totalling ₹45,370/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement made, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedies available in

accordance with law if aggrieved of the calculation of the amount.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

It is clarified that in case statement made today is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case, he is forced to do so, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable personally from the defaulting official.
