On 21.8.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail
in FIR No.40 dated 27.02.2019 registered under Sections
307, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections
25 and 54 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station
Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhaina.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends
that apart from the fact that the petitioner was allegedly
present at the time of incident, no injury is attributed to
the petitioner. He further submits that the only allegation
against the petitioner and other co-accused except
Kuldeep Singh @ Bittu is that they all exhorted Kuldeep
to use his fire arm.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. S.P.S. Tinna,

Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of

Punjab. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 27.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 21.8.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
