The petitioner in this case seeks a direction to the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, the first respondent not to dispense with his services till the time a regular appointment is made to the post occupied by him.

By order dated 04.12.2017, this Court directed that the petitioner should not be replaced by any other contractual employee.

The petitioner was admittedly engaged on contractual basis through an outsourcing agency as a Junior Engineer (Civil) by the first respondent-Corporation. This engagement was effected on 01.09.2014 and he is continuing since then without any break in service.

Mr. R.S. Randhawa, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.

Sourabh Goel, learned counsel for the Corporation would inform this Court

that a similar issue fell for consideration in **CWP-7302-2013** titled **Vir Singh Vs. Municipal Corporation, Faridabad and others** which was disposed of by order dated 05.07.2018. A copy of the said order is placed on record.

For reasons alike as were mentioned in the aforestated order and in terms thereof, the writ petition is disposed of directing the first respondent-Corporation to continue the petitioner as a Junior Engineer (Civil) on the same basis that he has been continued in service all along till a regularly selected candidate is appointed in his place. The petitioner shall not be replaced by another contractual employee.
