The complaint dated 09.08.2019 sent by petitioner-Darshan Kaur to the office of Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this Court was treated as criminal writ petition and taken on judicial side.

Vide order dated 22.08.2019, this Court appointed Warrant Officer to visit the place where detenues Harjit Singh and Avtar Singh were alleged to be detained illegally and get them released if they were found to be in illegal custody.

Now, the Warrant Officer has submitted the report, wherein it is stated that he visited the farm house of petitioner Darshan Kaur, who made the statement that her husband Harjit Singh and son Avtar Singh were taken away by the police when they were on way to Chandigarh, but on the next day, they had come back.
