Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.119 dated 23.07.2019, under Sections 353, 186, 201, 427 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the allegation in the FIR, the officials of the checking team, who went to the village to check the theft of electricity, were obstructed by the present petitioner.

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The petitioner has been in custody since 23.07.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
