Pursuant to the order dated 29.8.2019, an affidavit of Shri Manjit Singh Dhesi, Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, has been filed in Court today by Shri Balkar Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kotkapura, who is present in Court.

A perusal thereof shows that on account of the fact that the ASI who had come to ostensibly assist the learned State counsel on the last date of hearing (29.8.2019), did not know anything about the case, a departmental enquiry is stated to have been initiated against him.

Other than that, the DSP who is present in Court, submits that in fact the petitioner has been acquitted by the trial Court, of the charges framed against him under Sections 302 and 201 of the IPC, upon all material witnesses having turned hostile.

That being so, obviously this petition, by which the petitioner has sought regular bail, has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

The affidavit is ordered to be taken on record.
