Petitioner seeks a mandamus for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents.

Counsel has been heard at length.

Pleadings on record are insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Averments made in the petition would rather indicate that the petitioner as also private respondents are close blood relations and civil proceedings already stand initiated by both sides against each other.

The instant writ petition is merely a fallout of a civil dispute which is already pending.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
