TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA J.(Oral)

Petitioners seek a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Pleadings on record are grossly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In para 9 of the writ petition it has been averred that on the intervening night of 10/11 of May 2019, respondents No.4 and 5 alongwith two unknown persons had entered in the premises of the petitioners and had given beatings to the petitioners causing serious injuries on their body parts.

No medical evidence has been placed on record and neither has any document been adverted to during the course of arguments to substantiate such assertion. The allegations contained in para 9 of the writ petition do not inspire any confidence.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition dismissed.
