The petitioner has participated for the post of TGT (Science) under the SC category pursuant to the advertisement No.03/2015 (Annexure P-1). Out of 895 posts, 755 posts were meant for SC candidates.

Pursuant to the order dated 09.10.2018, the petitioner was provisionally interviewed and a direction was also given that her documents will be scrutinized before declaration of the final result.

On 22.05.2019 the result of the petitioner was produced. The final result was declared on 19.10.2018 and the petitioner had secured 82 marks in written examination and 10 marks in the viva voce. Total marks are 92 whereas the last selected candidate under SC category has secured 65 marks. The State was given an opportunity to get instructions whether at the time of scrutiny of documents, any objection was raised.

There is only question with regard to objection during scrutiny of documents.

Keeping in view the merit of the petitioner i.e. 92 marks which are much higher than the last selected candidate under the SC category, writ petition is being allowed. The petitioner will appear before the office of

Haryana Staff Selection Commission on 03.06.2019 and the Commission is directed to recommend the case of the petitioner for appointment after verifying the documents of the petitioner within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
