ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

In view of order dated 23.01.2019, passed by this Court, in CWP No.5162 of 2015, the issue raised in the present petition with regard to increase in the nomination fee to be deposited by the contesting candidates for the post of 'President' is rendered infructuous. As not only the election, nomination fee qua which was enhanced by the Election Committee, concluded in the meanwhile, even otherwise, the Draft Rules prepared by Sub Committee have been approved by the General House of Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association.

Any grievance with regard to increase in the nomination fee for elections to be held in future is a separate cause of action and the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the same, if

and when he feels aggrieved in future.

Also to be noted, that the petitioner has not challenged the draft Rules, approved by the General House, in September, 2018, in the present petition. The instant petition is rendered infructuous in view of the elections already having taken place.

Dismissed as infructuous.
