On 22.08.2019, the following order was passed:

" Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.0091 dated 09.07.2019, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the no recovery has been made from the petitioner and a co-accused has already been granted protection in CRM-M-31682-2019.

Notice of motion for 26.09.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumr, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-31682-2019"

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, co-operated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

Hence, the order dated 22.08.2019 is made absolute.
