ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.92 dated 25.06.2019, under Sections 384 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 13, 17 Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she is alleged to have demanded money from two boys by threatening them that she will involve them in a rape case. She further states that the petitioner is in custody for over 2 months. She is 35 years old lady with a minor child.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kishan Lal states that the petitioner is involved in two other similar cases. He further states that although the challan has been filed but no witness has been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in other cases and she has been acquitted in one of them.

In view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is a lady with a minor child, she is in custody for over 2 months and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
