The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.144 dated 24.05.2019, under Sections 379-A, 384 and 389 IPC, registered at Police Station City Narwana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is mentioned that co-accused Sudesh Devi along with two others had stolen the car of the complainant. The car has been recovered from the co-accused Sudesh Devi. The petitioner is in custody since 25.05.2019 and the co-accused Sudesh Devi had been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-29111-2019 on 16.07.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Roshan Lal, states that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 4 months, he is not named in the FIR and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
