RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for quashing the impugned terms and conditions for allotment of new chambers at the Judicial Complex dated 03.10.2017 (P5) and 21.10.2017 (P6) as also for quashing the impugned resolutions dated 18.09.2017 (P3), 27.09.2017 (P4) and 30.10.2017 (P7).

While appearing for the High Court, Mr.Bhullar has produced the extract of the Minutes of Meeting of the Hon'ble Building Committee of this Court held on 30.01.2018, which reads as follows:

“ xx xx xx xx

*Sh.Jagniwas S.D.M.Bahadurgarh is present and he
assures that the requisite agreement in view of the*

guidelines issued by Financial Commissioner & Secretary to Government of Haryana, Revenue Department vide letter dated 16.05.1994 shall be executed between the Office Bearers of the Bar Association, Bahadurgarh and Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar to regulate the affairs regarding allotment of chambers, for which the Office Bearers of the Bar Association, Bahadurgarh also undertake to comply with the same by doing the needful.

As regards to the complaints made by the Advocates regarding allotment of chambers or irregularities, the Committee requests Hon'ble Mr. Justice Amol Rattan Singh, Administrative Judge of Jhajjar Sessions Division to look into the matter and examine all those complaints, which will be submitted before the District and Sessions Judge, for which he shall issue circular amongst the lawyers inviting their complaints.

The Committee further resolves that in this matter the decision so taken by the Administrative Judge shall be final and binding in all respects.”

The administrative recourse has been achieved and the views of the Administrative Judge will be available in due course of time.

With these observations, the petition stands disposed of.
