B.S.WALIA, J. (Oral)

Learned DAG states that the matter can be disposed of in terms of the decision of the Division Bench of this Court dated 20.02.2019, titled State of Haryana and others vs. Devender in LPA No.1273 of 2018 along with connected matters and that in terms thereof the petitioners-chowkidars would be paid honorarium *at par* with revenue chowkidars.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners is satisfied with the stand of the learned DAG and states that the writ petition be disposed of in terms of the decision of the Division Bench in LPA No.1273 of 2018.

3. In the light of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of in terms of the decision of the Division Bench dated 20.02.2019 in LPA No.1273 of 2018. The petitioner-chowkidars are held entitled to honorarium *at par* with revenue chowkidars as held in the aforesaid decision by the Hon'ble Division Bench.
