AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a mandamus for directing the respondents to enter the Mutation No.7232 in the revenue record in compliance with the order dated 24.08.1959 passed by the Collector, Narnaul.

Perusal of the record would indicate that the petitioner had been sleeping over the matter and it is now that he has arisen up and thereafter approached the authorities. Ultimately an inquiry was held. On the basis of the inquiry, which has been held, it ultimately was concluded that the petitioner should avail of his remedy before the competent Court of jurisdiction as that was an old entry which has been entered into the revenue record, which cannot be changed at this belated stage i.e. in the year 2017. Petitioner, instead of approaching the competent Court of jurisdiction for the remedy, has filed the present writ petition.

This Court has given an option to the counsel for the petitioner to avail of the remedy in accordance with law, which the counsel for the petitioner has refused to accept.

In the light of the above, this Court does not find any merit in the present writ petition and the same, therefore, stands dismissed.
