KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

This writ petition in the nature of PIL has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus to command the respondents to investigate the prevailing corruption in the respondent department of Boiler as pointed out by the petitioner and to get the Boiler Operator certificates of all the Boiler Operators endorsed in Haryana verified. During the course of hearing on 02.04.2019, Mr. Deepak Balyan, Addl.A.G. Haryana pointed out from the record that Office of the Director Boilers, UP vide letter dated 6.9.2016, informed the Chief Inspector of Boilers, Haryana in respect of Boiler Attendants certificates of 19 persons, named therein, to be forged. On the basis whereof a direction was passed by the Chief Inspector of Boiler Haryana asking the police to register a First Information Report. Surprisingly, the police after investigation submitted a report in respect of

the licenses of Sanjay Shukla, Basant Kumar, Surender Kumar and Sarvesh Ranjan, that they were genuine and accordingly made a cancellation report. Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances, we vide order dated 02.04.2019, required Superintendent of Police, Panipat to appear in person along with complete record for rendering assistance in the matter. In compliance of the order, the Superintendent of Police appeared in person along with the record on 09.04.2019. After going through the record we required an affidavit to be filed annexing therewith all the relevant documents within two weeks. In compliance thereof a status report by way of an affidavit of the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, has been filed wherein it has been stated that after noticing the fact that Office of the Director Boiler U.P. had submitted a report in respect of the genuineness and validity of the licenses of certain boilers attendant which was miserably ignored at the time of filing the cancellation report, the investigation was reopened and a Special Investigation Team under the supervision of DSP, City, Panipat had been constituted to carry out a proper, fair and impartial investigation.

We are orally informed by Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, on the instructions from SI Rajesh Kumar that three persons have been arrested and further investigation by the SIT is in process.

We have no reason to believe that the investigation shall be carried out in a proper manner expeditiously and the matter would be brought to a logical end with the consequential legal action. With this, the

petition seems to have achieved its object and purpose and there exists no good reason to continue the same on Board. We have no reason to believe that the investigation shall not be brought to a logical end expeditiously. With the aforesaid observation the writ petition stands disposed of finally.
