This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take action on the representation (Annexure P-1) filed on behalf of the petitioner to the SSP (Rural), Jalandhar as well as the representation (Annexure P-3), again submitted to SSP Jalandhar and DGP, Punjab.

A perusal of the application submitted to SSP reveals that allegedly an attempt was made to take possession of the property of a temple. The allegations as contained in the application do not reveal commission of any cognizable offence.

Resultantly, no ground is made out to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
