In the present writ petition, the grievance which has been raised by the petitioner is that after the pay revision, which was effected w.e.f. 01.01.1986 though the pay of the petitioner was revised vide Annexure P-1 dated 17.01.1994 but the actual arrears were not released to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been making representations for the grant of said relief but the respondents have not reverted back granting the said relief. Learned counsel further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has given a representation to the respondents on 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-7) and another representation on 04.08.2018 (Annexure P-9). Learned counsel states that both the representations are still pending consideration with the respondent and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide

the representations by passing a speaking order.

Mr. Pawan Kumar, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that he has no objection qua the prayer of the petitioner for deciding his representations dated 30.05.2017 and 04.08.2018 (Annexures P-7 and P-9) respectively at this stage.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representations, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representations dated 30.05.2017 and 04.08.2018 (Annexures P-7 and P-9) respectively, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
