Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.52 dated 28.05.2019 under Sections 376, 511, 323, 342, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated August 26, 2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. Furthermore, even the matter has been compromised between the parties.

This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surjit Raj, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of

the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated August 26, 2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
