By way of present petition the petitioner has sought a direction to the respondents to release him on parole for a period of six weeks to enable him to meet his family members, to get his mother treated and also to get his house repaired.

In view of the uncontroverted position that the co-accused of the petitioner has been granted parole, this petition is disposed of with an observation that the competent authority may look into the request of the petitioner for grant of parole and if any ground is made out on parity with the co-accused who has been granted similar benefit, the petitioner may also be given parole for carrying out construction of his house as prayed by him. Let the decision be taken within a period of 60 days.
