The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.92 dated 08.06.2018, under Sections 22/61 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Distirct Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the recovery of 24 vials of Onerex and tablets of Carisoma has been effected from co-accused, namely, Parvesh Kumar. The petitioners were arrested along with co-accused Parvesh Kumar from the spot. He further contends that Carisoma tablets are not covered under the NDPS Act and co-accused, namely, Parvesh Kumar has been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-17275 of 2019, on 18.07.2019 where on he had undergone a period of one year and one month in custody. He also contends that the petitioners are in custody for about one year and six months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Bhola Singh, states that although charges have been framed but none of the nine prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the petitioners are in custody for about one year and six months, co-accused having been granted regular bail and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands disposed of.
