Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.101, dated 20.06.2018, registered under Section 379-B/34 IPC (Section 201 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner along with the co-accused had attacked on first informant with 'Datar' which hit on his left arm and due to injury blood started oozing out. It is further alleged that wallet containing Rs.1200/-, driving licence, two ATM cards and one health insurance card was snatched.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no medico legal report with regard to injury caused. He further submits that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of alleged confessional statement recorded when the petitioner was in police custody. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 13.05.2019.

On the other hand learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Gulzar Singh has submitted that the petitioner is involved in 2 more cases of such nature. It is not in dispute that those criminal cases are pending and the petitioner has been released on bail.

Investigations are complete, challan has been presented.
Petitioner is in custody since 13.05.2019. He is a young boy of 24 years.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 13.05.2019 and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
