ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, who has been working as a Driver in Punjab Roadways, Mukstar, met with an accident. As a result of the said accident, his leg has been shortened. The Civil Surgeon, Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide letter dated 15.04.2014 (Annexure P-4), has opined that petitioner has been found fit only for light duty. In pursuance to aforesaid letter, the petitioner has been assigned the route duty i.e heavy duty inspite of the fact that he is not fit to perform the heavy duty.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the medical condition of the petitioner is not sound and he has been found fit only for light duty, therefore, he be not assigned any heavy duty. The petitioner has also sent a legal notice dated 27.06.2019 (Annexure P-7) which has not been decided so far.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to decide the legal notice dated 27.06.2019 (Annexure P-7) within a period of one month from the

date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. Till the legal notice of the petitioner is decided, the petitioner shall be assigned light duty only.
