GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.66, dated 14.9.2018, registered at Police Station Women, NIT Faridabad, under Sections 354-B, 323, 380, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Learned State counsel has today filed reply by way of affidavit of Dhaarna Yadav, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, C.A.W. Faridabad. The same is taken on record. Copy of the affidavit has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Vide order dated 22.8.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
4. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad, has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioner/accused Sumit Paul and also of complainant Aradhana Paul @ Silky Chawla have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
5. The complainant in her statement has specifically stated that she has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
6. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
7. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.66, dated 14.9.2018, registered at Police Station Women, NIT Faridabad, under Sections 354-B, 323, 380, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
