Short reply filed by the learned State counsel today in Court is taken on record. There cannot be any serious opposition to the prayer of the petitioner to attend the Bhog ceremony (tervi) of his late grand-mother, who passed away on 14.08.2019. The ceremony is stated to be held tomorrow i.e. on 27.08.2019 in his native village.

Accordingly, petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted emergency parole for three days on his furnishing adequate surety to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate, concerned. The respondents are directed to release the petitioner at about 2.00 PM today i.e. 26.08.2019 and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Jail Authorities on 29.08.2019 before 4.00 PM.

Petition stands disposed of.
