Application is allowed.

Main case

Petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0100 dated 08.06.2019 registered under Sections 340/323/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (offence under Sections 452/295/295-A/506 of IPC have been added later on vide DDR No.22 dated 24.06.2019) at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the first informant-victim has informed the Court that correct translation of the FIR has not been produced by the learned counsel for the petitioners and deliberately 2-3 sentences have been left out.

Learned counsel for the first informant has read-over the

vernacular copy of FIR in the open Court. Assertion made by him regarding filing of the wrong translation of FIR is correct.

It has been pointed out that all the petitioners have a criminal background as there are two FIRs against petitioner No.1, one FIR each against petitioner Nos.2 and 3 and they are habitual offenders. List of different cases pending against the petitioners is extracted as under:-

“Petitioner No.1-Mandeep Singh @ Gorkha is an accused in:-

1. *FIR No.485 dated 27.07.2010 under Sections 394, 307, 323, 34 IPC Police Station Hanumangarh District Hanumangarh Rajasthan in which challan stands presented.*
2. *FIR No.25 dated 24.02.2009 under Section 18 of NDPS Act Police Station Bhikhi District Mansa.*

Petitioner No.2-Randeep Singh @ Nikka is an accused in:-

3. *FIR No.1 dated 04.01.2019 under Sections 325, 427, 34 IPC PS Sangat District Bathinda.*

Petitioner No.3-Sarabjeet Singh is an accused in:-

4. *FIR No.68 dated 13.06.2016 under Sections 341, 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC Police Station Sangat District Bathinda.”*

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioners is directed to remain careful in future lest the Court is compelled to pass some order.
