1. Challenge herein is to the seniority list dated 25.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) of Multi Purpose Health Workers(Male), working in Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Punjab. It is stated that the same is violative of Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India as the persons junior to the petitioner, have been shown senior to him.
2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner submitted a representation dated 17.10.2018(Annexure P-4) and thereby sought appropriate amendment/ modification in the seniority list, but no response thereto was received. In the premise, the petitioner caused a legal notice dated 10.12.2018(Annexure P-5), but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence, this writ petition.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.
4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 10.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.
6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
7. Disposed of in above terms.
