The present petition has been filed for extension of furlough by four weeks.

Petitioner was granted furlough by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar on 06.08.2019 and released from jail on 09.08.2019 for two weeks i.e. uptill 19.08.2019.

A report from Aadhar Health Institute has been placed on record as Annexure R-1 with the letter of the Superintendent of Jail, Central Jail-I, Hisar, addressed to the Advocate General Haryana, Chandigarh, dated 26.08.2019 in which it is advised that the patient would require post clinical observation as he is on loop ileostomy and he is required for weekly follow-ups for two months and as per requirement. The letter is taken on record. So also paper containing two photographs of the petitioner and the discharge slip from the Aadhar Health Institute are also retained on record.

Having considered the prayer, this Court deems it appropriate looking to the satisfactory conduct of the petitioner in jail and that he was granted furlough by the Commissioner Hissar Division to extend his furlough by another period of two weeks w.e.f 20.08.2019.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted extension in furlough period for two weeks from 20.08.2019 to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate concerned, who is further directed to impose such conditions as may be required to secure the presence of the petitioner in jail after the furlough period, is over and done with. The petitioner shall surrender in jail on 03.09.2019 before 4.00 PM.
