On 22.8.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail
in FIR No.40, dated 27.02.2019, registered under
Sections 307/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of
the Arms Act, at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District
Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies
upon an order passed in CRM-M-33701-2019 with
respect to a co-accused, who is similarly situated and the
role attributed to the petitioner and the co-accused is
same.

Notice of motion for 27.09.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar,
DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A
copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Sandeep
Kumar, DAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-33701-2019.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 22.8.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
