As per pleadings on record both the petitioners have attained the age of majority. They are stated to be in a live-in relationship.

Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the relationship/liaison between the parties, writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3, confined to the aspect as regards threat to their life.

In the eventuality of any such application, being preferred, respondent No.3, would be obligated to look into the matter and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
