By this common order, above mentioned two writ petitions are being disposed off as the same question of law and similar facts are involved in both the writ petitions.

Learned counsel for the parties agree that the question of law, which

is being raised in the present writ petition(s) by the petitioner(s) for the grant of benefit of service, which they had rendered with respondents No.3 and 4 to be taken into consideration while calculating pensionary benefits of the petitioners, has already been granted in the judgement passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.115 of 2006 titled as **Punjab State Electricity Board vs. State of Punjab and others** decided on 12.09.2008.

Learned counsel for the parties also agrees that the said judgement has already attained finality as the SLP (Civil) No.12028 of 2009 filed by the aggrieved parties has already been dismissed on 14.2.2014 by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. As the learned counsel for the parties agree that the case of the petitioner(s) in this writ petitions is covered by the judgement passed in LPA No.115 of 2006, the present writ petitions are also disposed off in terms of LPA No.115 of 2006 decided on 12.09.2008. Benefits, which have been extended to the similarly situated employees in terms of order passed by Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.115 of 2006, be extended to the petitioner as well on the same terms and conditions as stipulated by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.115 of 2006.
