On 22.08.2019, the following order was passed:

" Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.127 dated 01.08.2019, registered under Sections 353/294/186/506/34 IPC, at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. Petitioner never obstructed in discharge of duty being performed by first informant, who is official of the State of Punjab. He further submits that the co-accused has already been granted concession of regular bail.

Notice of motion for 26.09.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C"

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, co-operated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

Hence, the order dated 22.08.2019 is made absolute.
