Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General,
Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) in terms of the order dated 26.03.2019 (Annexure P-6) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 29.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) in terms of order dated 26.03.2019 (Annexure P-6) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioners is to be accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to them, in accordance with law and if the claim is not to be accepted, then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

It is made clear that in case the legal notice is not decided within two months, there shall be costs of ₹ 50,000/- to be paid to all the petitioners.
