Petitioners seek a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take out necessary steps for protection of their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Pleadings on record are insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

That apart during the course of hearing, counsel would concede that petitioner No.2 is already married to one Ruby. The previous marriage has not been dissolved. Rather averments made in para 5 of the writ petition are that the first wife of petitioner No.2 has no objection to the marriage that petitioner No.2 has now performed with petitioner No.1.

In an overview of the matter, no interference is warranted.

Petition dismissed.
