Transfers being matters of administrative exigencies, this Court generally refrains to interfere in the same unless extreme case of harshness is made out.

The present case does not make out a case of any such harshness and, therefore, I am not inclined to interfere in the extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

However, writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to treat the present writ petition as a representation and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law particularly keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned transfer orders was passed in violation of the Transfer Policy.

It would be appreciated that appropriate order is passed as expeditiously as possible.
