AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.5.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 14538 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above and without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without even going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No. 4 i.e. the Executive Engineer, Project Public Health, Division No. 1, Deluxe Building, U.T. Secretariat, Chandigarh and to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 30.4.2019 (Annexure P-2) and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a

certified copy of this Court.

Needless to observe that in case any outstanding amounts/funds are found due, the necessary funds would be released to the petitioner without any further delay.

Disposed of.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of order dated 27.9.2019 in court, the same is taken on record and copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that legal notice has been decided and payments of the bill cannot be made as the same are yet to be verified.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 27.9.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
