On 26.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.67, dated 08.05.2019, registered under Sections 323/341/506/148/149 IPC(later on added Section 326 IPC), at police Station Nangal, Tehsil Nangal, District Rupnagar, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay of 17 days in lodging the FIR and the petitioner is a juvenile. He further submits that 2 co-accused who were juvenile were granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

Notice of motion for 31.10.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kishor Chand, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 26.08.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
