**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioners seek a Mandamus for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Counsel for the petitioners has been heard at length and pleadings on record have been perused.

Petitioners herein are none other than real parents and sisters of respondent No.4.

It is not in dispute that petitioner No.1 had instituted a suit for mandatory injunction against his own son/respondent No.4 to vacate the house in question and to deliver the possession thereof and such suit was decreed by the trial court on 28.02.2017. Respondent No.4 having filed an appeal, the same has been dismissed. Even execution proceedings initiated by the petitioner No.1 are stated to be pending.

The instant writ petition can only be seen as a fall out of a property dispute inter se family members.

Pleadings on records are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Confronted with the situation when this court was not inclined to interfere, counsel at this stage seeks withdrawal of the writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
