In pursuance to the order dated 28.03.2019, an affidavit is being filed on behalf of respondents No. 1, 3 and 4. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 1, 3 and 4 states that prayer of the petitioner has been accepted and the benefit of ₹5 lacs has been extended to her as being demanded by her in the present writ petition. Learned counsel for respondents No. 1, 3 and 4 has brought a cheque which has been delivered to counsel for the petitioner for onwards transfer to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that as the amount has

been released after an undue and unexplained delay, petitioner is entitled for interest on the same, for which, the petitioner will make a representation to respondents No. 1, 3 and 4 and they be directed to decide the same in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case coupled with the settled principle of law settled by the Full Bench of this Court in ***A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab, 1997(3) SCT 468.***

Learned counsel for respondents No. 1, 3 and 4 very fairly states that in case any such representation is received claiming the interest, the same will be decided by passing an appropriate order in view of the settled principle of law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the above, no further grievance of the petitioner is left to be addressed and he does not want to press the present writ petition any further, at this stage.

Writ petition is disposed of as not pressed.
