There being no other criminal case stated to be registered against the petitioner and the recovery of the poppy husk from her (as per the case of the investigating agency) being marginally above commercial quantity and a co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Harjinder Kaur, already having been admitted to bail by this Court, the petition is allowed, with the petitioner ordered to be admitted on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is to be noticed that as per instructions of learned State counsel, no prosecution witnesses have been examined so far, with the petitioner having been in custody for about 05 months.
