The petitioners have sought a mandamus to direct the respondents to ensure compliance of the provisions of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 (hereinafter to be referred to as 'the 2012 Act') and as a consequence thereto, to get the elections of respondent No.5, Park Plaza Condominium Association conducted by appointing an administrator.

During the course of hearing today, Mr. D. Khanna, learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of the District Registrar of Societies Gurugram, respondent No.3. The same is taken on record and a copy has been furnished to counsel opposite.

In para 5 of the reply, it has been stated that an order dated 05.05.2017 appended as Annexure P-24 along with the writ petition has already been passed by respondent No.1 for conduct of elections of the respondent/Association as per procedure under the 2012 Act.

Mr. Rajeev Anand, learned counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.5/Association and apprises the Court that the issue is a subject matter of adjudication in **CWP-29094-2017 (Siddharth Punia & others Vs. State of Haryana & others)** and a Division Bench of this Court on 20.12.2017 while issuing notice in the writ petition has stayed the impugned order therein at Annexure P-6 which is none other than order dated 05.05.2017 (Annexure P-24) along with instant writ petition.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to seek redressal and by taking out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

Writ petition is disposed of.
