The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.389 dated 10.07.2019 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Palam Vihar Lines, Gurugram.

The operative part of the order dated 27.08.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the complainant booked a consignment through Safe Express Packers Movers for delivery to a destination at Bangalore. It is further stated in the FIR that consignment was to be delivered on 01.07.2019 and therefore, finding some suspicion and foul-play, the FIR has been registered with the aforesaid allegations. It is further submitted that consignment has already been delivered on 10.07.2019 against a receipt and delay in delivery of the consignment was that the complainant himself has not made the balance payment,

on account of some unavoidable circumstances.

Notice of motion for 25.09.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 27.08.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Azad Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 27.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
