The petitioner has filed present criminal revision against the judgment dated 14.03.2019 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Sirsa, Camp at Dabwali, whereby the petition under Section 125 Cr.PC filed by the respondents seeking maintenance was partly allowed and the petitioner was directed to pay Rs.4,000/- per month to respondent No.1 and Rs.2,000/- per month to respondent No.2 as maintenance from the date of filing of the petition i.e. 16.07.2016.

Vide order dated September 11, 2019 passed by this Court, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the parties were directed to appear there on 24.09.2019.

A report dated 14.11.2019 has been received from the Mediator to the effect that the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement and a settlement/compromise dated 14.11.2019 has been reduced into writing. The settlement/compromise is made part of the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the aforesaid settlement/compromise dated 14.11.2019, the petitioner has paid a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- to the respondent No.1-wife by way of bank drafts amounting to Rs.85,000/-, Rs.10,000/- and Rs.5,000/- respectively. He has produced the photocopy of those bank drafts in Court, which are taken on record.

He further states that since the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, the parties shall adhere to the terms and conditions of the settlement/compromise dated 14.11.2019 in letter and spirit.
