Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.162 dated 11.07.2019 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 26.08.2019: -

“... Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the dispute is arising out of an agreement to sell vide which the complainant alleges that he has paid the earnest money of Rs.5 lacs. Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the bank statement to submit that the amount has been returned by making a payment of Rs.3 lacs and Rs.2 lacs, on two occasions and the complainant never filed

any suit for specific performance for enforcement of his right and the FIR has been registered only on the pretext that he wants his money to be returned....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
